The title of your passion project is going to be in question form, in a THICK-QUESTION format.

Thin Questions

*Can be answered very easily

*Usually can be answered with one word

*There is not much discussion needed to answer a thin question

*The answer can be easily found-It is "Googleable" *Answers are on the surface

> Examples of Thin Questions Ex. Who is the main character? Ex. Where does the setting take place?

> > Thin Questions start with: Who... What... Where... When...

Rough Idea of Your Thick Question

Thick Questions

*Harder to answer *Needs evidence to help answer the question *There might be many answers *Answers have depth *Need background knowledge to help answer the question *Answers might be open-ended-"Non-Googleable"
